MBYC Amenities:

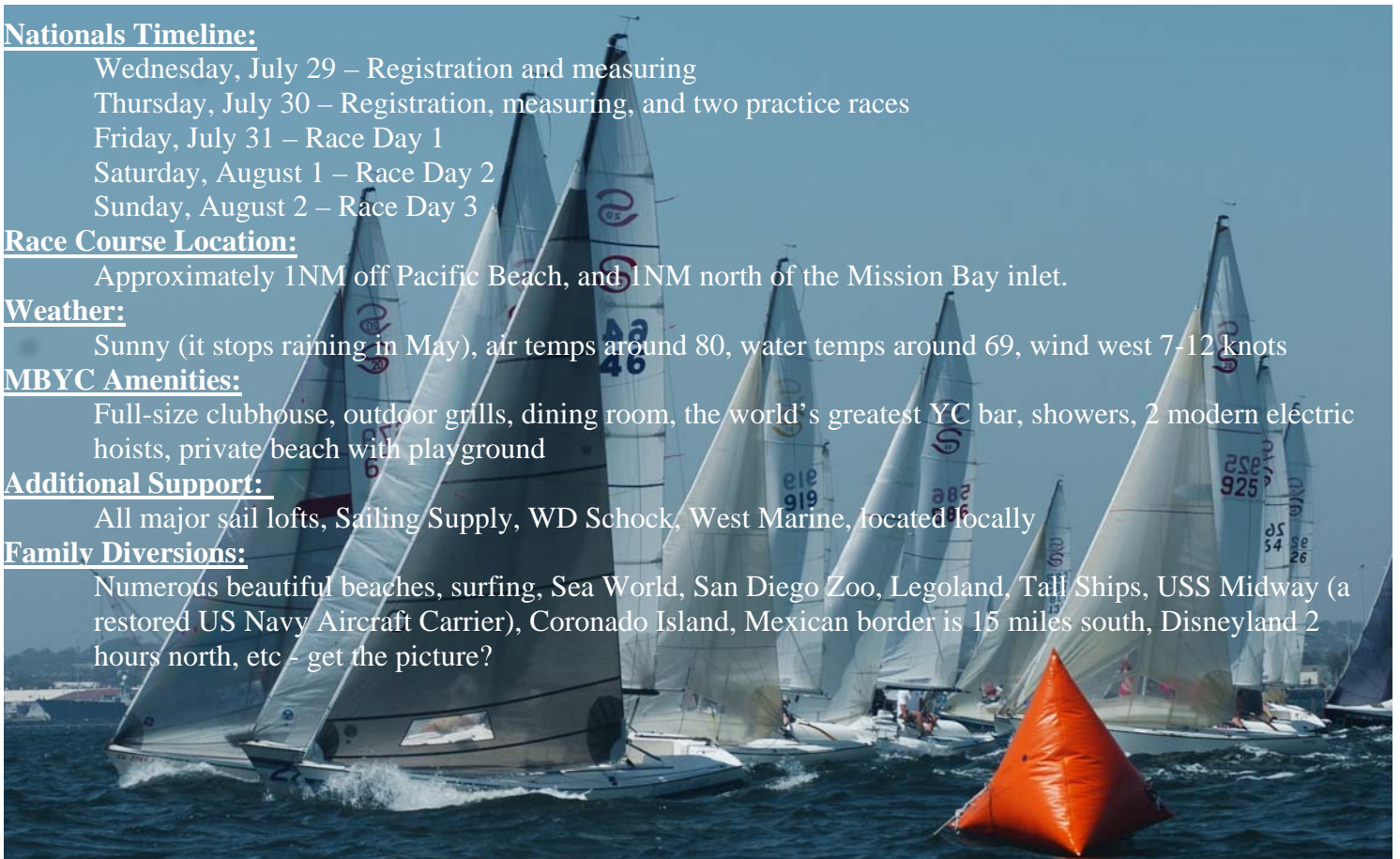
Full-size clubhouse, outdoor grills, dining room, the world's greatest YC bar, showers, 2 modern electric hoists, private beach with playground
