Eligibility & Entry

The Regatta is open to dinghies, centerboard, multi-hull and keel boats. Entry forms will be available no later than March 1, 2011 and eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form found on the WSC website at www.whiskeytownsailing.org, and sending it, together with the required fee to

Boats will be placed in divisions based on the type of boat and number of entries of each type.

Rules

The Regatta shall be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012, the Notice of Race (except as modified in the Sailing Instructions) and the Sailing Instructions.

Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be supplied with the registration packet upon skipper check in. Preliminary Sailing Instructions will be available on the Whiskeytown Sailing Club website, www.whiskeytownsailing.org on or before May 1, 2011. The Whiskeytown Sailing Club reserves the right to amend versions of the Preliminary Sailing Instructions on the website without prior notice.

Venue

The racing area shall be the main body of water of Whiskeytown Lake. A detailed map is at www.whiskeytownsailing.org, under the "Resources" tab.

Courses

The courses will be random leg courses, selected from those published and furnished with the registration packet upon skipper check in.

Scoring

Four races are scheduled. All boats will be scored using the Portsmouth Yardstick. The Regatta will be scored as provided in the RRS except that all races will count towards a boat's final score.

**Launching, Berthing
Dry Storage**

A launch ramp is available at Brandy Creek Marina. Limited guest berthing slips at Brandy Creek Marina may be available. The fee is \$20.00 per night. When checking in, inquire at Regatta Headquarters for guest berth availability. Overnight dry storage is available in the parking area at Brandy Creek Marina.

Prizes

Three trophies shall be awarded for each class.

Attention Sailors

Quagga & Zebra Mussels and Parking Permit information. Whiskeytown Lake uses a "[self certification package](#)" for sailors to verify that their vessels have not been in waters where Quagga or Zebra mussels are present, or if they have been in such waters, the boats have been thoroughly dried and cleaned before coming to Whiskeytown. Please print out the Self Certification Package found on the Park web site at www.nps.gov/whis. It is a three page package. Page 1 provides information about Quagga and Zebra mussels. Page 2 is a questionnaire regarding your boat. Page 3 is a form which you as skipper must sign and display on the dashboard of your tow vehicle when it is parked at the Brandy Creek Marina parking area. The form certifies that your boat will not threaten Whiskeytown Lake with Quagga or Zebra mussels.

Please be advised that vehicles in the Park must display a valid parking permit, which can be purchased at the Whiskeytown Lake Visitors Center at a cost of \$5.00 per day. Weekly and annual NPS permits are also available and acceptable.
