The responsibility of wearing a life jacket rests upon the Skipper/Owner and their crew . If assistance is provided by Committee vessels and personnel, it is at the risk of the participants.

I accept full responsibility for the conduct of each member of my crew and guests during the Class Championships. I acknowledge that I have sole responsibility for the safety of my crew and yacht.

In consideration of your accepting my entry for the Santana 20 Class Championships, I do for myself, my executors, my administrators and assigns waive and release any and all claims that I have against Alamitos Bay Yacht Club and the Santana 20 Class Organization, their officers, directors, members, committee personnel, volunteers, employees and agents, or any one or more of them or their executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, or assigns, including any or all claims for damage caused by the negligence of any of them arising out of my participation or that of my yacht in the Class Championship and its related activities, including pre-start and post-finish operations and shore activities together with any costs and expenses including attorneys fees that may be incurred as a result of any such claim whether valid or not.
