

## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The event will be organized by Alamitos Bay Yacht Club 7201 East Ocean Blvd, Long Beach, CA. 90803 in conjunction with Fleet 13 of the Santana 20 Class Association.

### 2. RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

### 3. ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY

All Santana 20 class members in good standing and who have met the "three regatta requirement" (Article IX, Section 7) are eligible to compete. Upon receiving a class member's written request, the Santana 20 Class Board of Directors may waive the three regatta requirement in cases where it is impractical for a class member to meet this requirement (e.g., from an outlying area or other unique circumstances).

### 4. REGISTRATION

- 4.1 **The completed entry form and the registration fee, of one hundred and fifty U.S. dollars (\$150) if paid by August 1, 2004, or one hundred and seventy five U.S. dollars (\$175) if paid thereafter, by either check or money order made out to the Alamitos Bay Yacht Club. Entries must be received no later than Tuesday, August 10, 2004.** Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the ABYC Class Championship chairman.
- 4.2 The entry fee will cover the entry, the class-sponsored Post Race Seminars Thursday and Friday, the Thursday evening Burger Bash, the Friday "Surprise" Burger Bash and the Saturday night Luau / BBQ for the skipper and 2 crew members. Additional dinners may be purchased at a nominal cost on your entry form.

**6. MEASUREMENT**

- 6.1 Measurement is scheduled for Thursday August 12, 2004 from 0900 – 1300 and 1630 - 1800.  
6.2 All boats will be measured according to Santana 20 Rules and inspected for safety equipment.  
6.3 Each competitor's four (4) required class sails must be registered for the championship by being stamped by the championship measurer at ABYC. These four (4) sails are the only sails a competitor shall use once racing commences. Substitute sails may be approved by the chair if a sail is severely damaged.  
6.4 Only sails that have never been measured and stamped prior to the 2004 championship will be required to be "fully measured" on-site. Sails to be fully measured must be done so on Thursday during the scheduled measurement times. No sails will be fully measured on Friday morning.  
6.5 A "Competitor Compliance Acknowledgement" will be a part of the measurement form and will cover such items as: required safety gear, visible float marks, etc. A competitor may be subject to random measurement spot checks for compliance by the championship committee at any time during the series.  
6.6 All boats are subject to additional measurement at any time at the reasonable discretion of the Class or Race Committee.

**7. CHARTERED BOATS**

- 7.1 Boat chartering will be on first come first served basis.

**10. SCORING**

- 10.1 The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply.
- 10.2 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.3 When fewer than seven (7) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 10.4. When from seven (7) to eight (8) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

**11. PRIZES**

- 11.1 The Santana 20 Class Championship Trophy for the boat winning the Regatta.
- 11.2 Prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew of the boats finishing first through tenth (1-10) in the Regatta.
- 11.3 Special Awards for notable and or deserving deeds will be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Committee.

- 12.2 A social package will also be available for those not racing.
