Weather and sea conditions must be evaluated by each Skipper/Owner and their crew and each participant is responsible for determining whether it is safe for he or she to participate. The responsibility of wearing a life jacket rests upon the Skipper/Owner and their crew. If assistance is provided by Committee vessels and personnel, it is at the risk of the participants.

I accept full responsibility for the conduct of each member of my crew and guests during the Santana 20 Class Championships. I acknowledge that I have sole responsibility for the safety of my crew and yacht.
