Post Race: Awards Presentation

This race is one of the longest fresh water lake races offered in the northwest. It covers the entire length of Klamath Lake which is approximately 44 miles up and back. The race is approx. eight to twelve hrs. of widely varied wind, weather and water conditions with breathtaking scenery. This race can get rather grueling at times so be prepared. In past races, winds at the north end of the lake have blown 25-30 kts with higher gusts. This race is open to Keel boats only and will be handicapped under PHRF Northwest prescription.

TRANS- KLAM MULTIHULL ENDURO JUNE 7TH, 2008 SAME SCHEDULE AS TRANS KLAM

The Multihull Enduro is open to all multihull boats. This race covers the same water as the above Trans-Klam but sailed on a Multihull. This race will be handicapped under Portsmouth Prescription. The Trans-Klam Multihull Enduro should finish before dark, but no guarantees. All you Multihull Racers, this can be a real challenge. Are you up to it? Of course. See you in June.

This regatta will be governed by IYRU rules with US Sailing prescriptions except as may be altered by class rules or as directed by the sailing instructions for this race. Handicapping will be by PHRF Northwest for keelboats and Portsmouth Prescriptions for open centerboard and multihull boats. Five or more boats in a class may be scored as a fleet. Five races are scheduled, there will be no throw-outs. A minimum of three races will constitute a regatta. Although average wind speeds are approx. 8-12 kts., be prepared for winds between 0 and 20+kts.
