Sunday is a distance pursuit race, which will take you from Richmond Yacht club towards San Francisco City Front around Alcatraz and Angel Island, through Raccoon Straits and back to the club.



Conditions:

Fall brings mellow breezes and sunshine in the Bay. You can expect breezes 5 to 15, but don't leave home without the jib. Currents can run strong in the bay and especially in Raccoon Straits. The combination of breeze and current makes for challenging sailing conditions.

Facilities:

RYC is located North of San Francisco just off the I-80. The club has 2 hoists that can haul a S20 and plenty of overnight moorage space is available. The club is known for putting on excellent regattas and great parties.
